But we can do something... We should:

- Be involved in our child's online life
- Keep up-to-date with their development online
- Set boundaries in the online world just as we would in the real world
- Know what connects to the internet and how
- Consider the use of parental controls on devices that link to the internet, such as the TV, laptops, computers, games consoles and mobile phones.
- Emphasise that not everyone is who they say they are
- Know what to do if something goes wrong
